

31st Street Bridge Replacement Over the C&O Canal Notice of Short-Term Temporary Daytime Road Closure 31st Street Between M Street, NW and South Street, NW Thursday, May 23, 2019 10:00AM – 1:00PM

Project Information

The 31st Street Bridge is located in Georgetown and spans the C&O Canal. The bridge is supported on stone masonry abutment walls and an 1867 cast iron multi-column pier. DDOT is replacing the structurally deficient, weight-limited bridge. In the process, the existing historic pier will be removed, restored, and reset.

Temporary Short-Term Temporary Daytime Road Closure

In order to prepare for the installation of the project's temporary pedestrian bridge, 31st Street - between M Street, NW and South Street, NW - will be closed between 10:00AM and 1:00PM, on Thursday, May 23, 2019. There will be flaggers onsite to facilitate traffic movement. Parking, local deliveries, and pedestrian and bike traffic will be maintained at all times.
